Screening tuberculosis in ILI and SARI Clinics

In response to the COVID pandemic, patient attendance in general OPD has reduced almost to less than a half of regular days due to different Government advisories, protocols, lock down and fear of contracting COVID.**These factors have, in spite of laboratory remained fully operational, reduced sputum examination and T.B. case notification**. Field activities of health workers also significantly gone down or completely halted leading to reduction in referral of presumptive T.B. cases from field staffs.

The mater should be considered on priority basis and effective measures to be taken by the Medical Officers of PHC, CHC and District Hospital to take the opportunity of the ILI and SARI Clinics for screening of tuberculosis as well, because the clients of these clinics have similar respiratory symptoms like that of pulmonary TB. Screening for T.B patients should be also done during house hold visits. Emphasize on contact tracing of T.B. patients.

Lab Tech will use simple PPE like hand gloves, N95 mask, face shield and plastic apron for examination of samples from Non-COVID cases. Due to safety reason, sputum sample will not be collected from COVID +ve cases and people with history of high risk exposure till molecular test result is -ve for COVID.

The VHND(Village health & nutrition day) should also be utilized, for generating awareness on TB as well as referring TB cases for examination. ANM / ASHA will talk for a few minutes on symptoms of TB, where to seek help, importance of early treatment, regular and complete treatment, respiratory hygiene, BCG vaccination and also on different schemes of Government of India for TB patients.Chapter on TB is included in the training module for ASHAs and ANMs and most of them are trained & retrained.

Respective Deputy Commissioners and D.M.& H.O. to kindly supervise the above mentioned activities.
