Sir,

I am directed to inform you that one of the important decisions emerged in the meeting with Chief Secretary post the Video Conference with Cabinet Secretary, Government of India on 22nd March, 2020 is that Director of Health Services is to depute additional staff with District Surveillance Teams Shillong and Tura to provide support services on a daily basis to all the persons who are registered their recent travel history through 108 (or) online registration system.

While 108 is used as a front end to register the persons who have the travel history to affected places, the District Surveillance Team should collect the date of those travellers from 108 and only registration system to follow up with those travellers on a daily basis to make sure that anyone are following strictly the home quarantine advised to them
