


### Syndromic Cases reported during April 2023




## Presumptive Cases reported during April 2023



## Laboratory Cases reported during April 2023





## **Ongoing outbreaks**

#### 1. Chickenpox

District: East Khasi Hills

No. of Cases: 23

No. of Deaths: 00

#### **Public Health Event:**

On 22<sup>nd</sup> April 2023 the ANM of Thieddieng sub centre inform the District Surveillance Unit about clustering of Chickenpox cases in Nongshluid village. An event alert was generated and Outbreak Investigation was immediately initiated.

#### **Public Health Actions:**

- 1) Ongoing Active search for cases with similar symptoms in the village.
- 2) Data collection in a specially designed epidemiological case sheet.
- 3) Line listing of cases.
- 4) All cases are being advised to isolate at home until the rash/lesion have crusted over.
- 5) Follow up of the cases by the Health workers.
- 6) IEC in the school and community.



#### 2. Rabid Dog Bite

District: East Khasi Hills

No. of Cases: 25

No. of Deaths: 00

#### **Public Health Event:**

On 22<sup>nd</sup> of April 2023 multiple cases of Dog bite by a Rabid Dog were reported from Jaiaw area. On receipt of the information the District Surveillance Unit immediately initiated an investigation.

#### **Public Health Actions:**

- 1) Active and Passive search for the Rabid Dog Bite cases.
- 2) Line listing of all the cases.
- 3) All cases are receiving Post Exposure Prophylaxis as per protocol.
- The Shillong Municipal Board captured the Rabid Dog on 23<sup>rd</sup> April 2023.
- 5) IEC with special focus on Rabies prevention and the importance of Post exposure prophylaxis
