ADVERTISEMENT FOR AUXILIARY NURSING & MIDWIFERY (A.N.M)
TRAINING SESSION 2024-2025

Online Application in prescribed format for 2 years course in Auxiliary Nursing & Midwifery (ANM) Training session 2024-2025 are hereby invited up to **23rd June, 2024** till **3:00 P.M.** For details and online submission of form, visit website www.meghealth.gov.in

1. **Eligibility:** Female candidates who are indigenous inhabitants or permanent residents of the State are eligible to apply subject to fulfillment of the following criteria:
 - (i) Age: Minimum age for admission will be 17 years as on 31st December 2024.
 - (ii) The upper age limit is 35 yrs.
 - (iii) The minimum educational qualification shall be 10+2 recognized by MBOSE/ CBSE/ ICSE/SSSCE/HSCE or a recognized equivalent examination. Vocational stream ONLY passing out from recognized Board.
 - (iv) Applicants shall be medically fit.
2. Application which does not fulfill the requirement as per INC will be rejected. No application will be accepted or entertained after the last date of submission.
3. Candidates are required to appear before the Screening Committee which will be held on the **18th & 19th July, 2024** from **8:00 A.M - 4:00 P.M** at Female Health Worker Training School Ganesh Das Govt. MCH Hospital, Shillong and Civil Hospital, Tura. The Applicant will also be medically examined at the same time.
4. The list of candidates eligible for Screening will be displayed in the Notice Board of the Directorate of Health Services (MI) Shillong, Female Health Worker Training School Ganesh Das Govt. MCH Hospital, Shillong, Office of the District Medical & Health Officer, Tura Civil Hospital, Tura and in Government website.
5. The applicants are to bring along with all the relevant documents in originals at the time of Screening.
6. To minimize the delay and hardship to the candidates, screening will be arranged in order of merit and aggregate percentage of marks obtained at the qualifying examination which will be approximately two/three times the number of seats available category-wise.
7. Selection of candidates who are medically fit and eligible will be made purely on the basis of merit and subject to reservation policy of the State Government.
8. The list of selected candidates eligible for the undergoing the course will be displayed on the notice board of DIRECTORATE OF HEALTH SERVICES (MI), SHILLONG and OFFICE OF THE DISTRICT MEDICAL & HEALTH OFFICER, TURA, WEST GARO HILLS and in Government website. No individual intimation will be served on candidate selected.
9. Selected candidates are to report immediately to the Joint Director of Nursing, Directorate of Health Services (MI) for further instruction as the case may be.
10. Selected candidates who fail to report according to the fixed date will automatically lose their right to nomination and the next eligible candidate from the merit list will be nominated.

Further, note the Govt. will have no obligation to employ the passed out trainees.
Henceforth, as per the INC resolution there will be no Service Bond.
