2. Minimum Qualifying Criteria for AY 2025-26:

All candidates seeking admission must qualify the National Eligibility cum Entrance Test (NEET-UG) conducted by NTA for the corresponding academic year.

3. Eligibility Criteria

1) Eligibility for Seats under the State Government Quota Seats:

- i. Candidates must be either Scheduled Tribe or Scheduled Caste (including Other Scheduled Tribes and SC) of Meghalaya, holding a valid certificate issued by the competent authority in the state.

or

a permanent resident of Meghalaya possessing a Permanent Resident Certificate (PRC) issued in accordance with Government of Meghalaya Political Department Letter No. POL.97/74/174 dated 10th July 1983.

4. Eligibility for Seats under the Management Quota Seats: The following conditions shall be fulfilled by the candidates namely -

- Candidates must be a citizen of India.

5. Eligibility for Seats under the NRI Quota Seats: -

- Non-resident Indian (NRIs) are eligible for admission subject to rules and regulations framed by the State Govt & the Govt of India as the case may be. The NRI applicants/candidates have to upload a certificate from the Indian Diplomatic Mission in the country of their residence in support of their claim as an NRI.

6. Other Eligibility Criteria:

- i. The age of the candidates shall not be below 17 years on the 31st December of the years in which the admission shall be sought for.
 - ii. The candidate should be medically fit and to be certified by a medical board constituted by the Health & Family Welfare Department, Government of Meghalaya.
7. Merely appearing and qualifying in NEET (UG) – 2025 does not confer any right to the candidate for admission to MBBS Course. The selection and admission to MBBS course in any Medical Institution recognised for MBBS Course is subject to fulfilling the admission criteria, eligibility, rank in merit list, medical fitness and such other criteria as may be prescribed by the Government of Meghalaya.
8. All candidates intending to apply for the counselling **MUST COMPLETE THE ONLINE APPLICATION** by submitting the application form through the website: www.meghealth.gov.in

9. DECLARATION AND VERIFICATION OF APPLICATION DETAILS

- i. All entries in the online application form must be filled in by the candidate with utmost care and diligence. The candidate shall be solely responsible for the correctness and accuracy of all information provided, including academic marks, category status, and enclosures uploaded or submitted.
- ii. Candidates are hereby informed that the information furnished in the application form, including marks obtained in the qualifying examination and supporting documents, shall be subject to verification and scrutiny by the concerned authorities. If, at any stage of the admission process or during the course of study, it is found that any information or document submitted by the candidate is false, fabricated, or incorrect, then:
 - a. The admission shall stand cancelled forthwith, irrespective of the stage of the course at that time.
 - b. The candidate shall be debarred from seeking admission to any course under the State Government quota for a period of three years;
 - c. Appropriate legal and/or criminal proceedings shall be initiated against the candidate and, where applicable, their parents/guardian, for submission of fraudulent documents such as Meghalaya ST/SC/OST and Permanent Resident Certificates.

10. Detailed Schedule of Counselling

The schedule for the Second Round of Counselling will be notified in the government website.

11. Counselling Procedure:

Counselling for all State Quota, Management Quota & NRI Quota will be conducted by the Meghalaya State Counselling Authority for Medical Education (MSCAME).

- i. **Online Registration:** Candidates must register online for the Meghalaya MBBS counselling process through the official website of the Health & Family Welfare Department, Government of Meghalaya at www.meghealth.gov.in
- ii. **Seat Allotment:** The seats are allotted based on the candidate's merit (NEET rank) and reservation criteria for State Quota. The seat allotment is done in multiple rounds (as per the detailed scheduled)
- iii. **Document Verification:** Candidates must appear for document verification, where they are required to submit original documents such as:
 - Age Proof Certificate.
 - UG-NEET Score Card (2025) & Admit Card.
 - Domicile certificate/Permanent Resident Certificate (if applicable)
 - Class 10 & 10+12 mark sheets and passing certificates.
 - ST/SC Certificates (if applicable).
 - Passport size photographs
 - Passport verification (for NRIs).
 - Certificate from the concerned Indian Diplomatic Mission in the Country of their residence in support of their claim as an NRI.

Admission Confirmation: Once a seat is allotted, the candidate must confirm their admission by paying the required fees as stipulated by USTM in case of State Quota, Management Quota and NRI Quota, if applicable and submitting the necessary documents to the allotted medical college within the stipulated date and time.

NB:

- a) Candidates who have joined state quota seats through earlier rounds are not eligible to participate in stray vacancy round of UG Counselling 2025.
- b) For any queries or clarifications regarding the State Quota Stray Vacancy Round, candidates are advised to contact the Meghalaya State Counselling Authority for Medical Education through the notified official communication channels.
