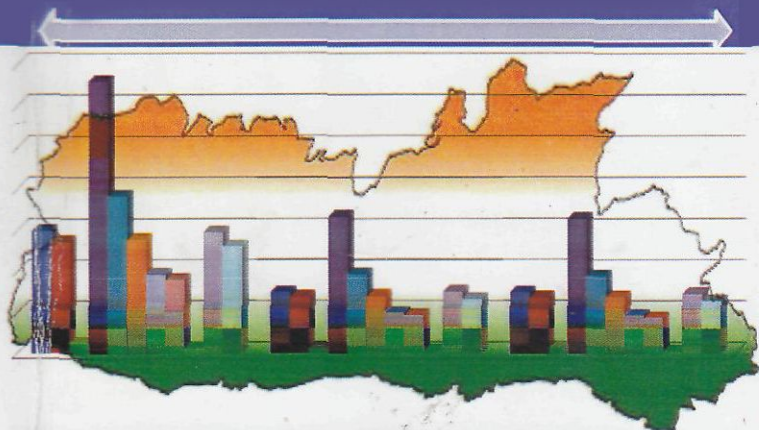

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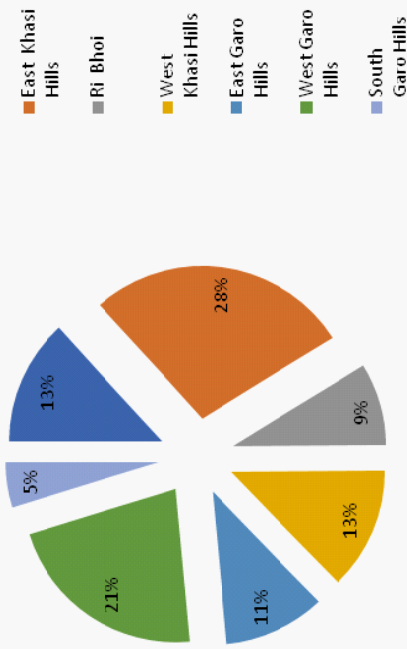
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DISTRICT WISE POPULATION 2011

GROWTH OF POPULATION 1901-2011

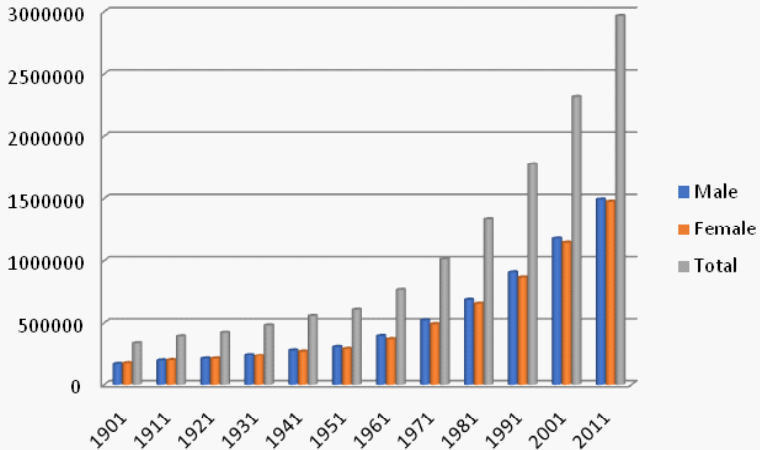

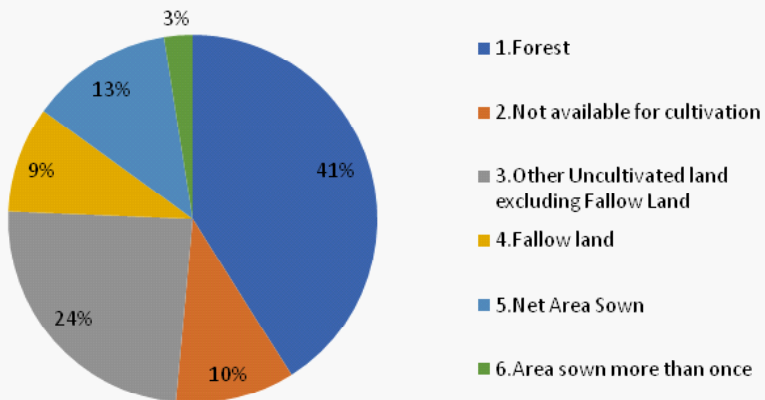

AREA UNDER RICE MEGHALAYA (in hectares)

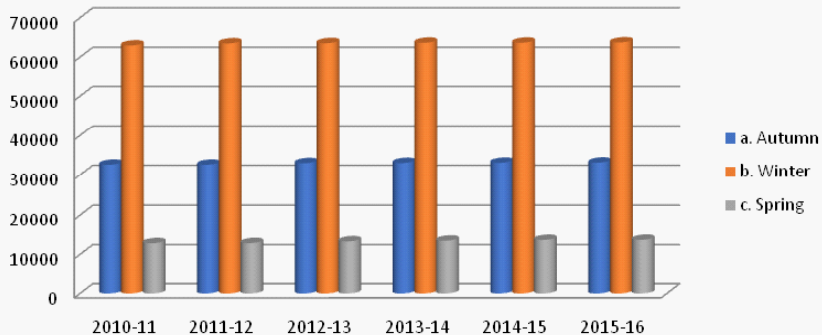

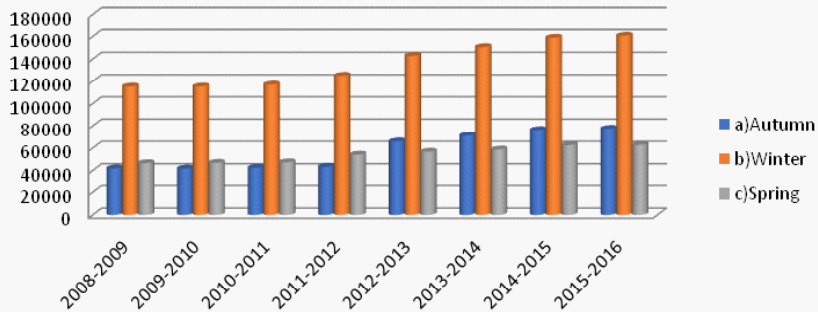

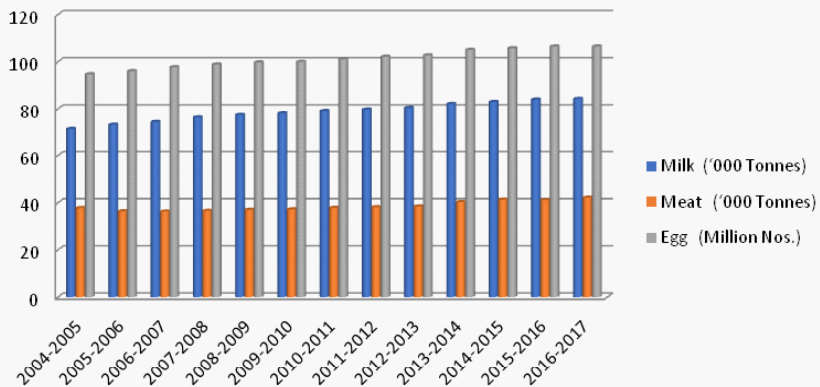

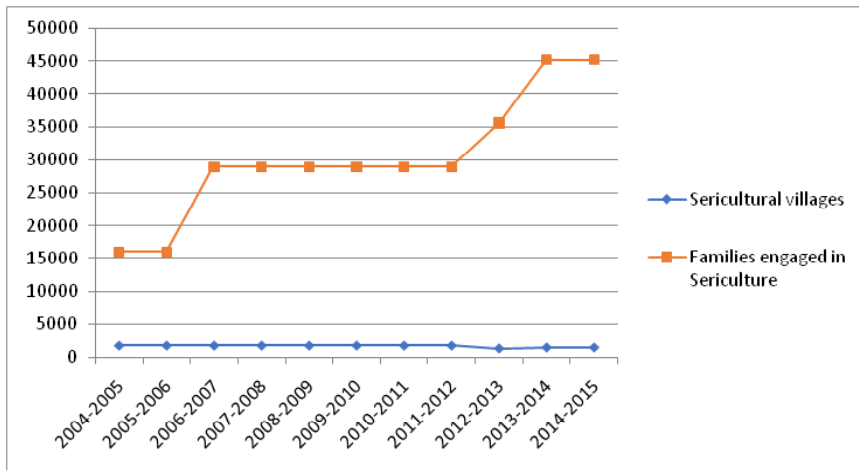

No. of Villages Electrified

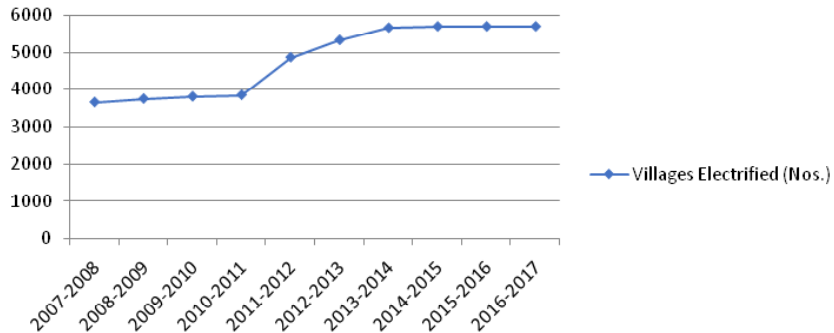


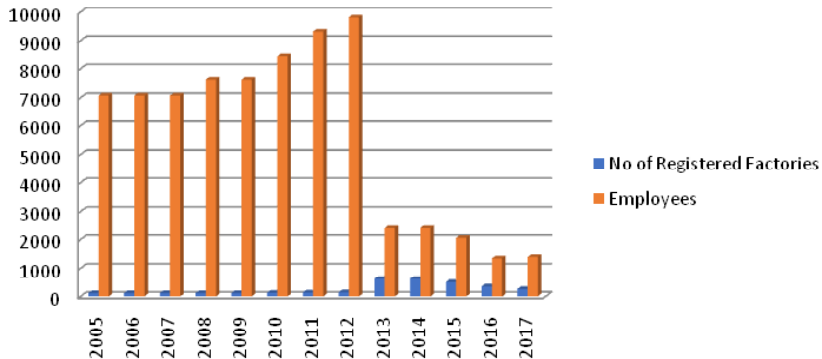

PRODUCTION OF COAL & LIMESTONE

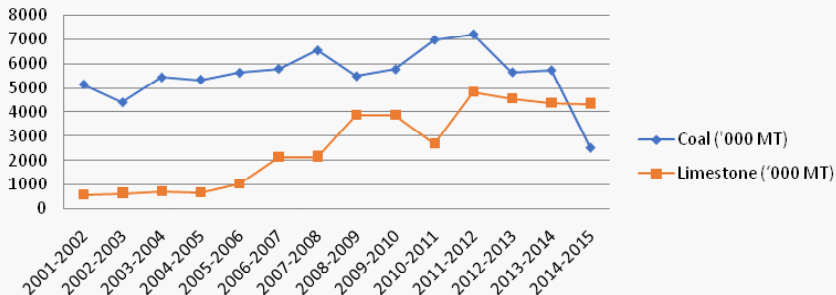

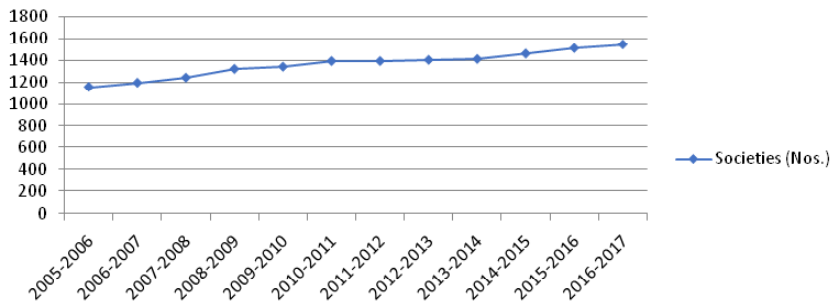

ROAD LENGTH BY CLASSES OF ROADS

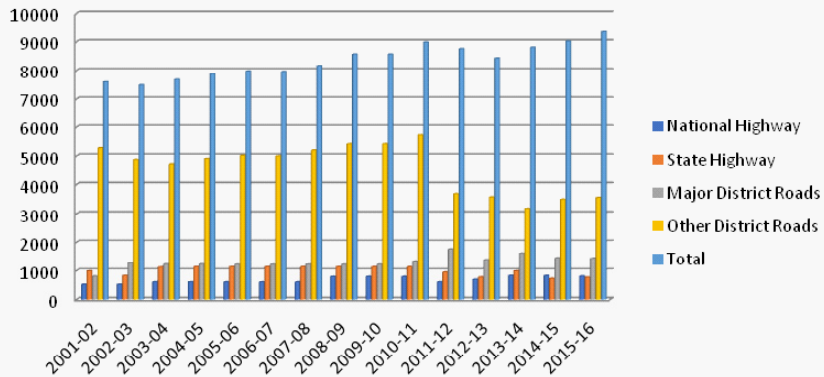

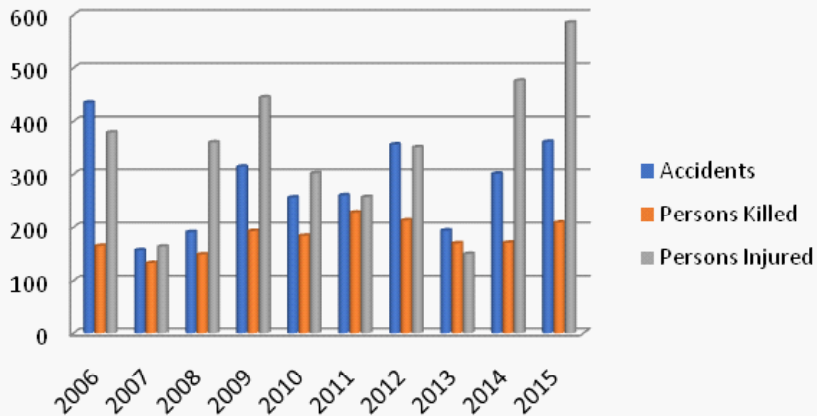
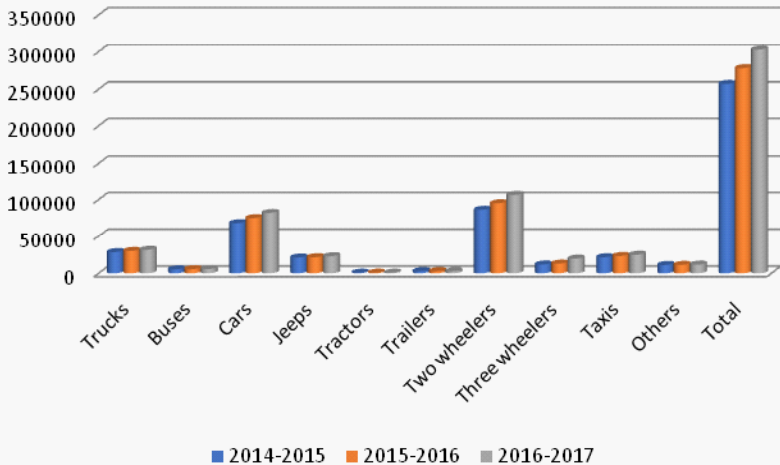

Birth & Death Rate Meghalaya, All India (Rate per '000)

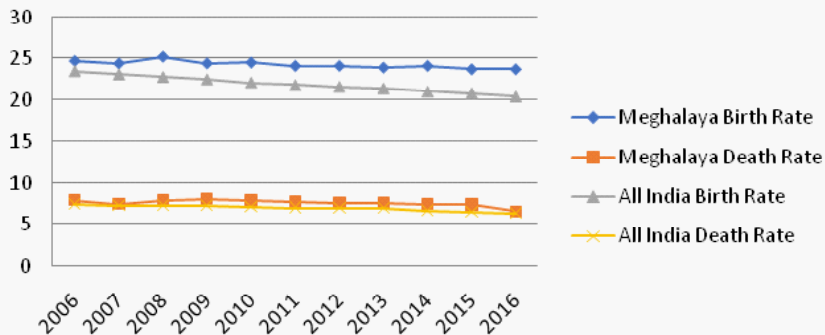

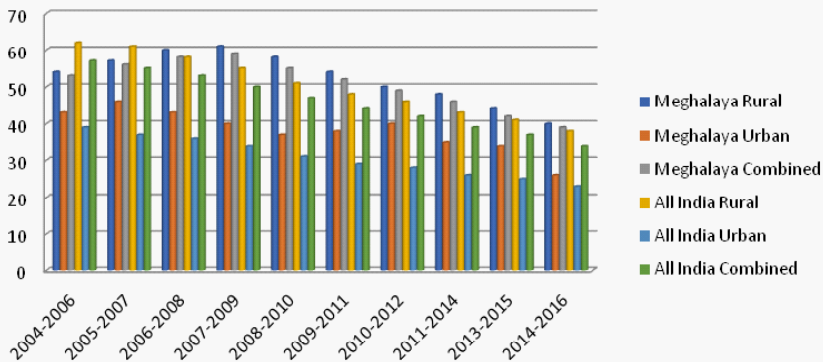
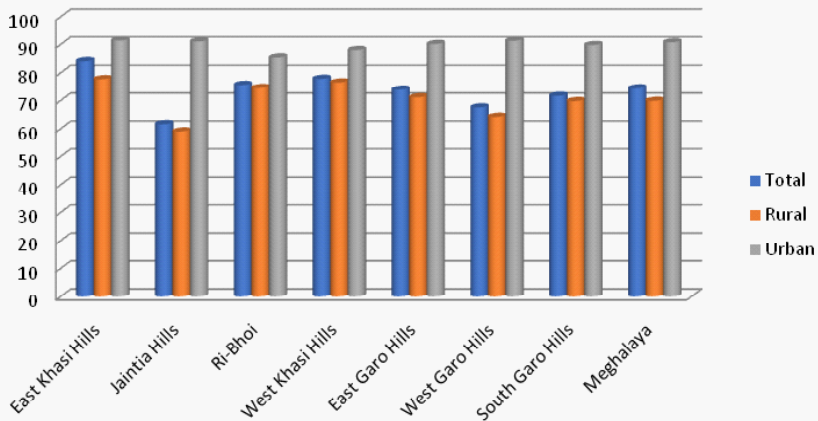

Revenue Receipts of the State of Meghalaya

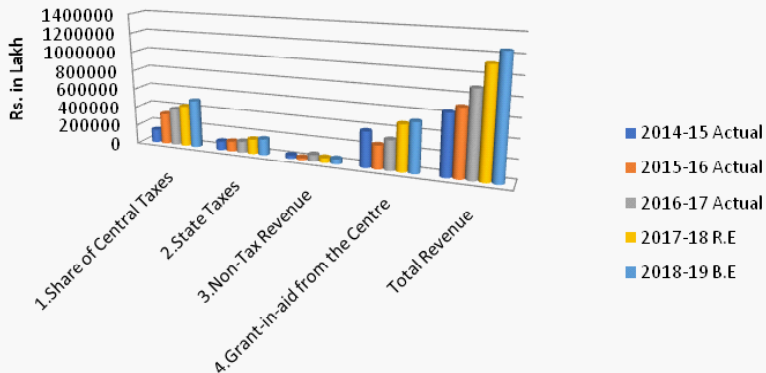

Revenue Expenditure of the State of Meghalaya (Rs. in lakh)

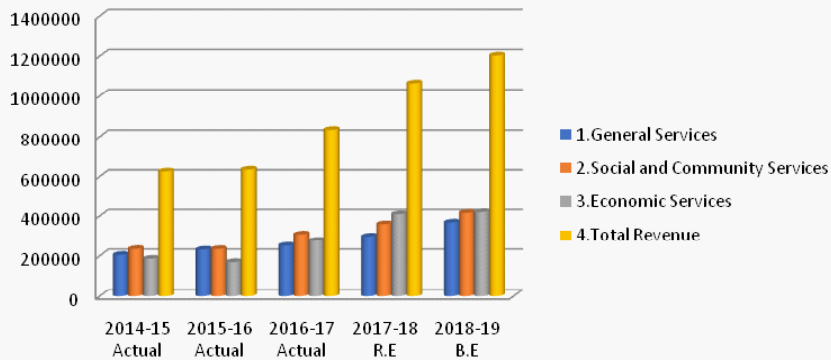
